

CRAPS TIPS

Craps is essentially a game of chance, both when playing at land-based casinos and online casinos. That being said, there are craps tips that can be followed to increase your chances of a positive outcome.

Understand the Odds in a Game of Craps

In order to place the best bet, it is essential to understand the odds in a game of craps. Up to twenty players can be standing around a craps table at any one time, plus a large number of spectators. It is a very exciting game with a lot of noise and buzz and it is easy to get caught up in the moment. If you do not have a clear understanding of the odds of the game, it will be very difficult for you to place the most worthwhile bet.

Which Bets Should you Place when Playing Craps

Craps is a complex game to learn as such there are many bets that can be placed. Once you have mastered the types of bets that are available, however, the rest is fairly straightforward. If you remain focused and aim to place the most worthwhile bets possible, you can definitely walk away a winner in the game of craps. The simplest bet to make and the one that is most reliable is the pass line bet. If you only place pass line bets, you are likely to come out ahead. Don't pass bets with maximum odds usually do well, as well. Come bets are also quite popular, but you should only place these bets if you are ahead and the current shooter tends to throw a large number of point numbers. Make sure to avoid proposition bets as the house has a huge advantage over the player. Some players are attracted to proposition bets due to their high pay outs, but this is not a good strategy to take.

Have a Long-Term Game Strategy for Craps

Most casino games require you to be prepared to lose a little on the way to winning and craps is not different. It is highly unlikely that you will win every bet that you place, but you should not become disheartened too quickly. As long as you have a bankroll, stick to it and you will win as well. A generally good craps tip is to raise as you win and lower as you lose. Do not quit after a win - it is a good opportunity to win more.

Understand Craps Etiquette Rules

Due to the large numbers of players at each craps table, there are a number of etiquette rules that are important for you to follow. These apply a lot more to land-based casino craps where you are actually present at the table than to online craps. You will not be popular around the craps table if you disrupt the game because you are not following basic etiquette rules. Some examples of these rules are keeping your hands off the table, keeping your chips on the rails that are provided for the purpose and collecting your money when appropriate.

Stick to your Bankroll when Playing Craps

As with all casino games, it is important to have a bankroll set aside for a game of craps. Do not bet with money that you do not have or money that is set aside for another purpose. Losing house-hold expenses money, for example, will make you anxious and therefore not play calmly. This is a recipe for losing. Once you have used up your bankroll, quit the game and try again another day.
